After reading and discussing "Katelyn's Fair Share Picnic," partners play this fun game to practice their division skills.

Preparation of Materials ...

- ▼ run Card Set ft on yellow construction paper and Card Set B on blue construction paper
- mount Fair Share mat on construction paper (to create a border)
- ▼ laminate
- "counters" are <u>not</u> included (you will need 15 counters of two different colors per game)

! Hint:

If you do not have colored counters, give children different colored cubes, beans, or squares of paper to use as counters.

Directions ...

- ♥ place cards face down in two different piles
- ♥ Partner A choose one yellow card and one blue card
- Partner ft divides the number on the blue card by the number on the yellow card and tells Partner B the answer
- ♥ if Partner B agrees with the answer, Partner ft places their counter on the answer on Katelyn's Fair Share mat
- ♥ if they are unable to make fair shares or the answer is already covered, they lose their turn
- play continues until one player has three counters in a row (vertically, horizontally, or diagonally)


