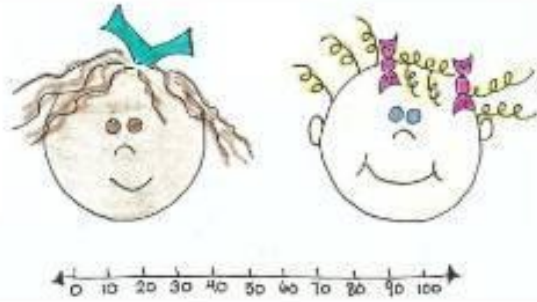

Preparing your materials ...

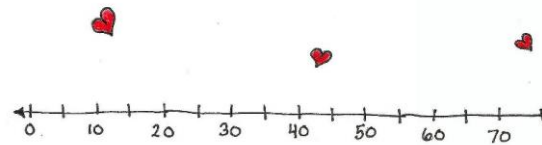
- ♥ copy number lines and number cards on construction paper

Hint ...

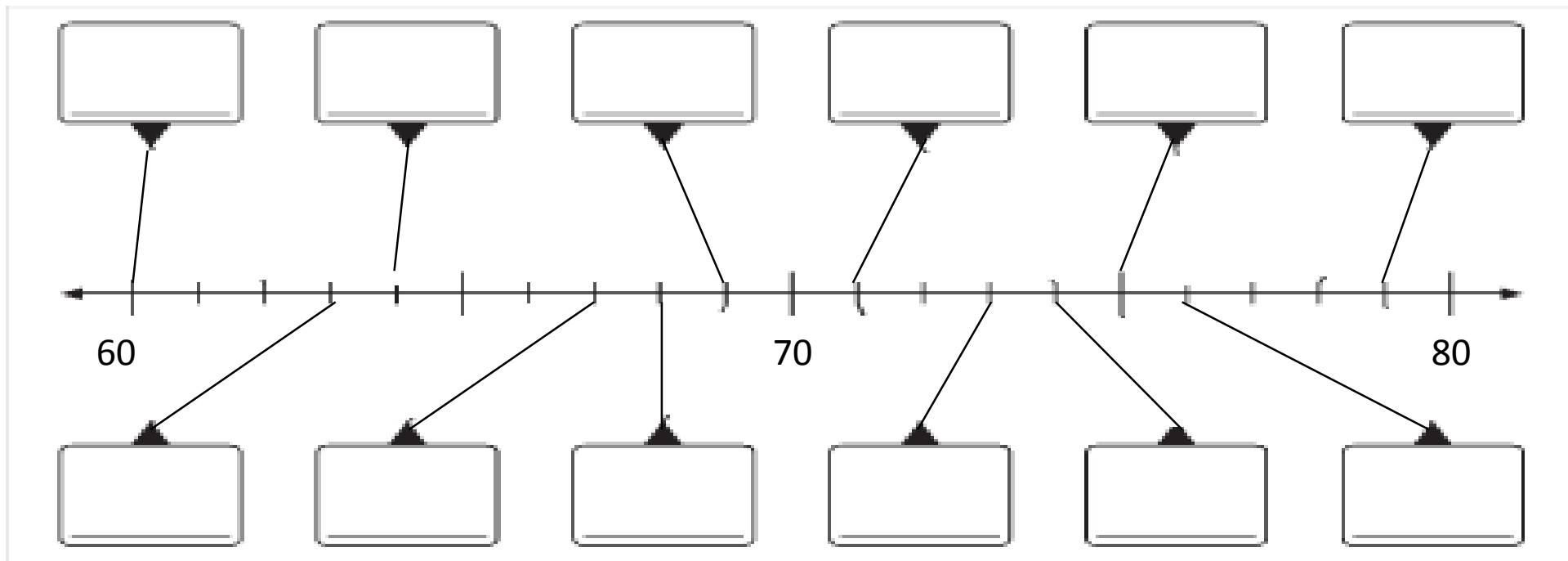
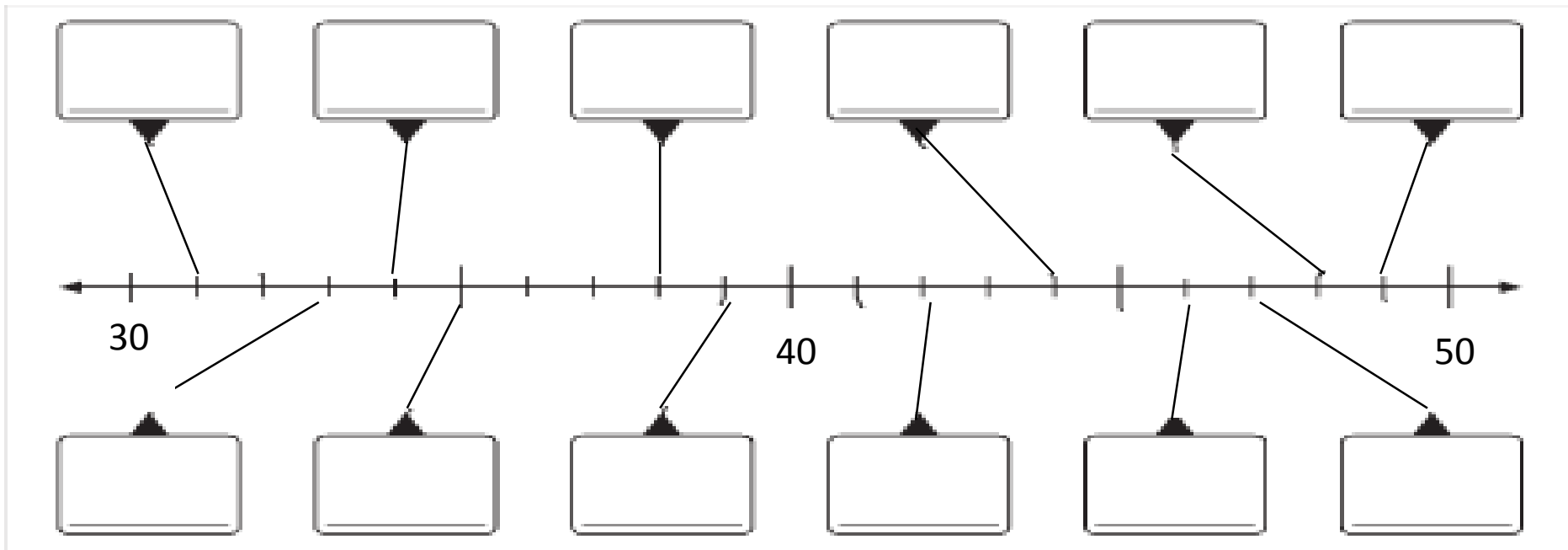

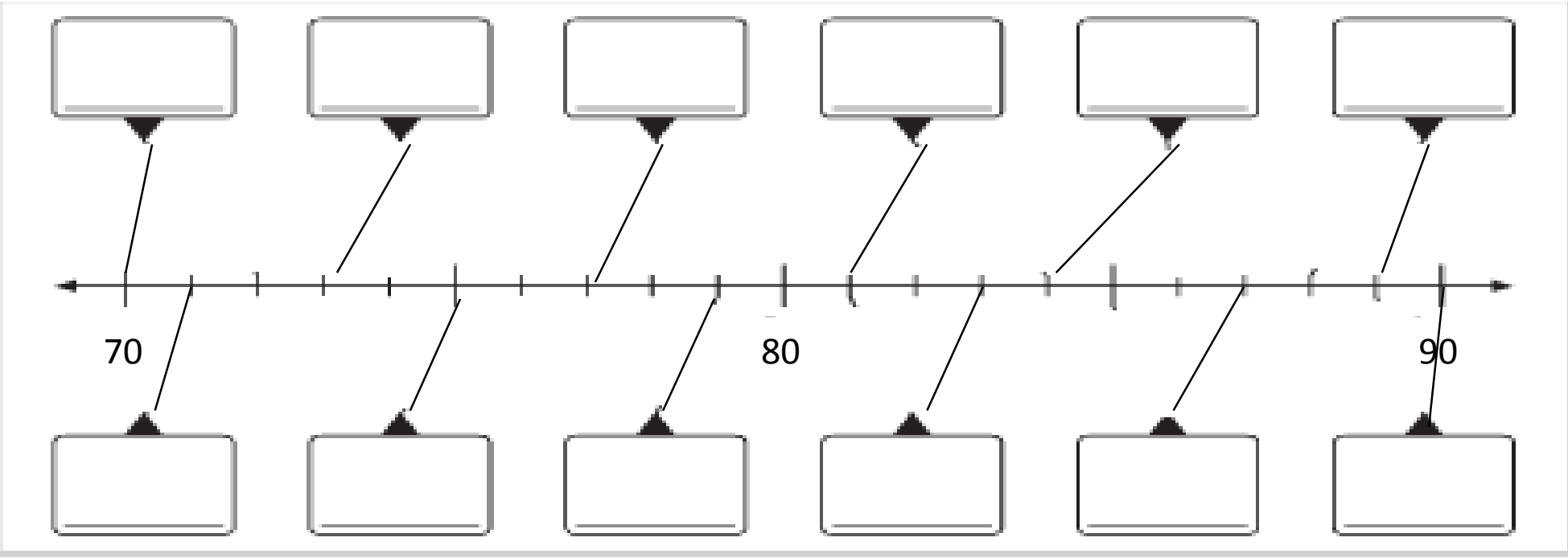
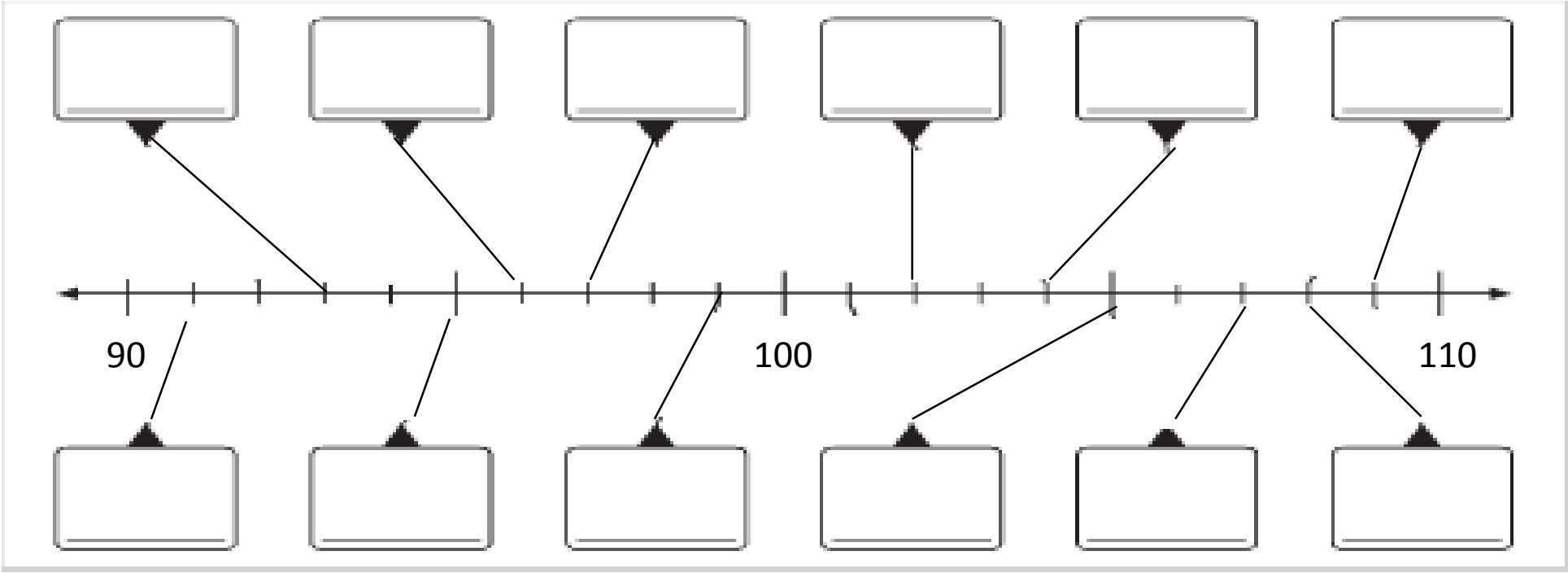
Directions ...

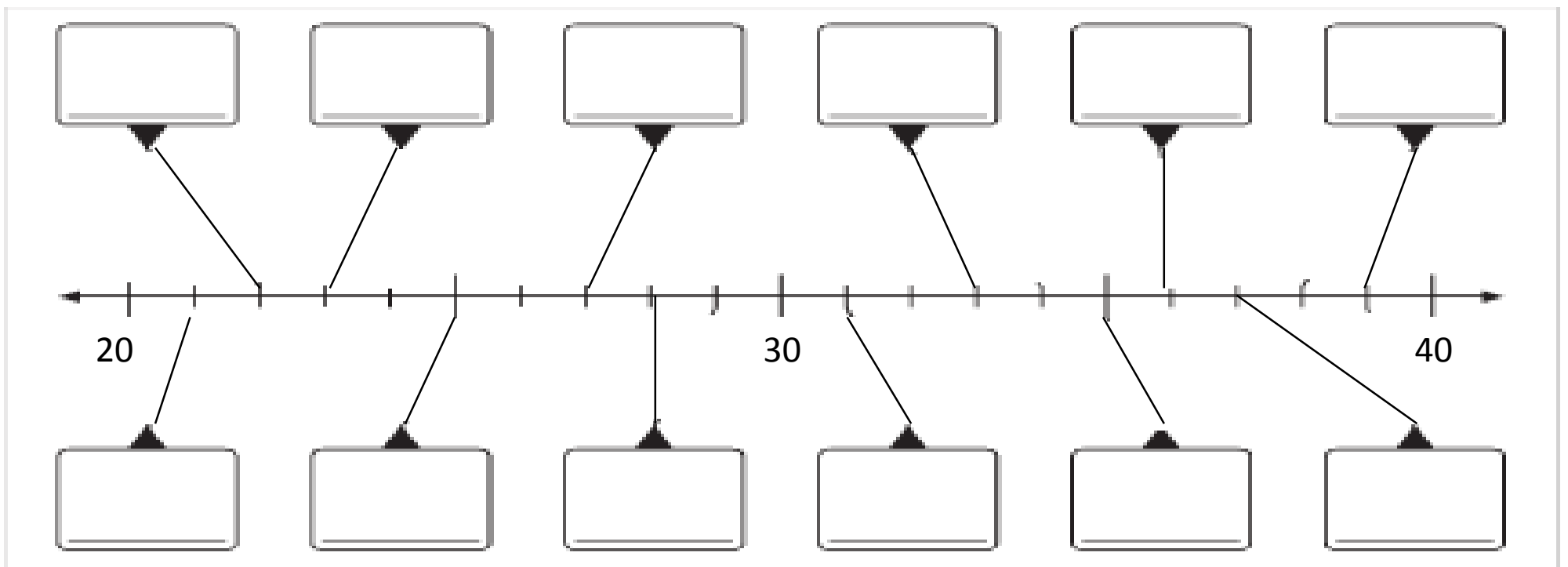
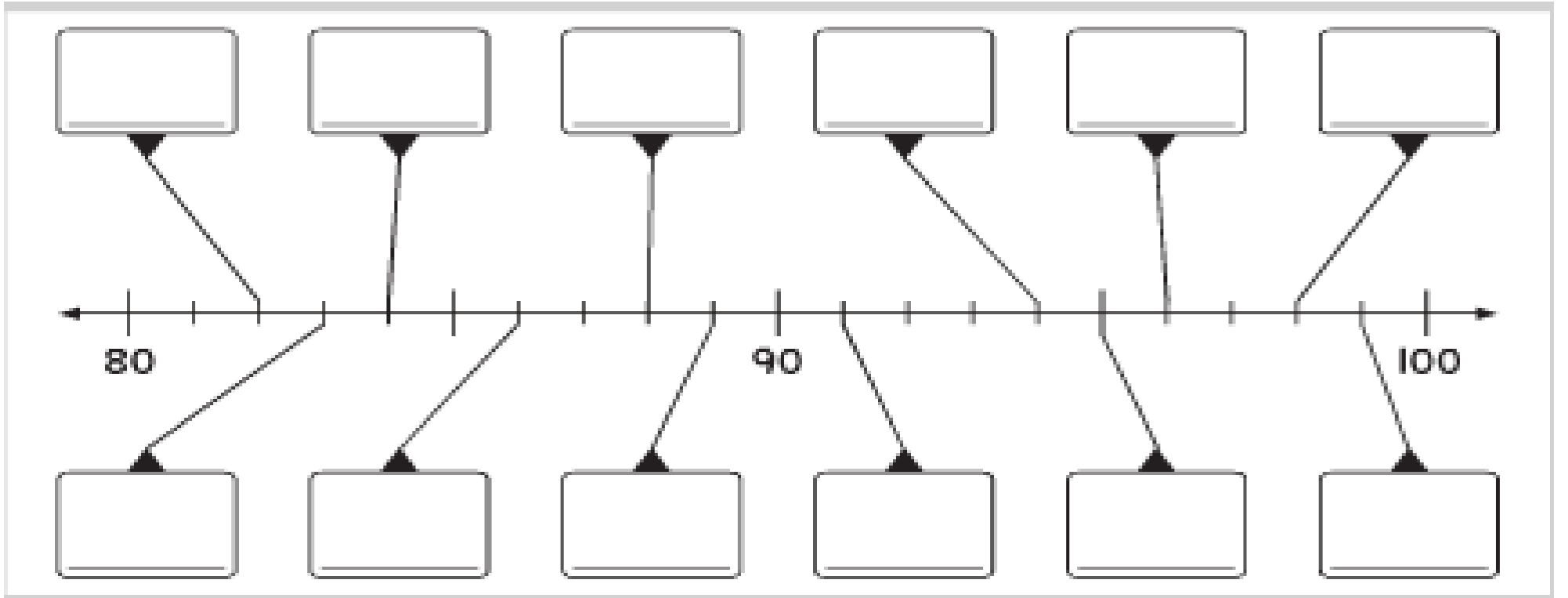
- ♥ children may work individually or in pairs placing the number cards on the correct position on the number line
- ♥ if working with a partner, both partners must agree that it is the correct number before it can be placed on the number line

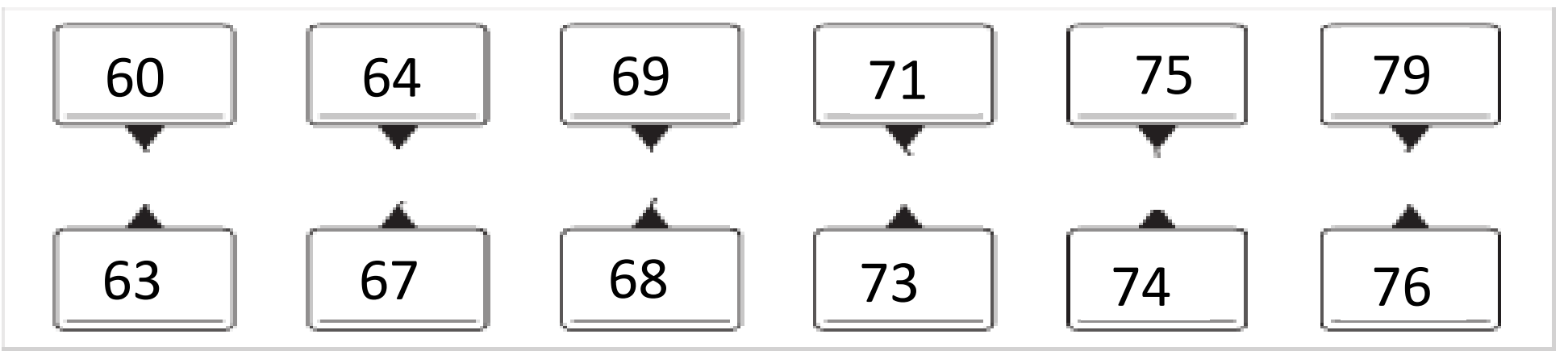
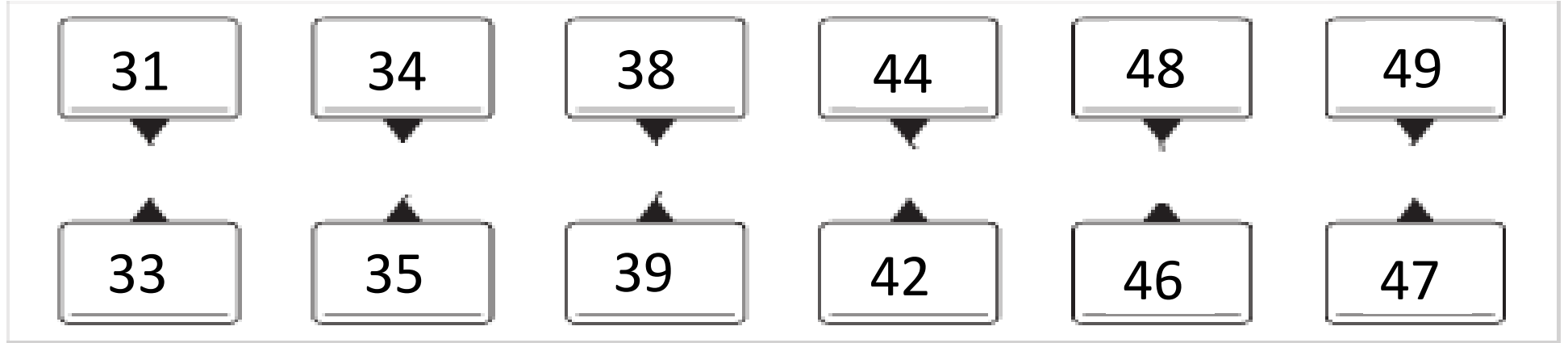
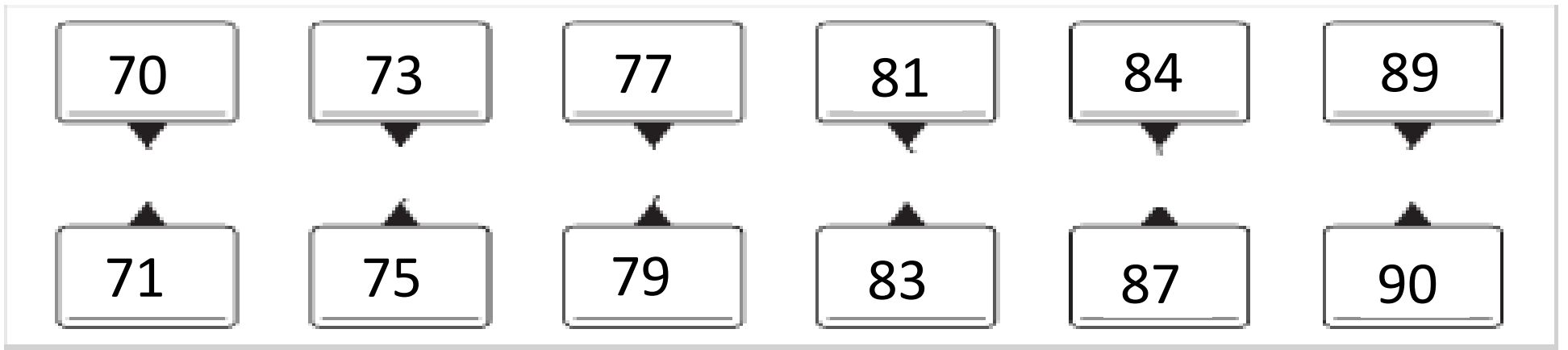


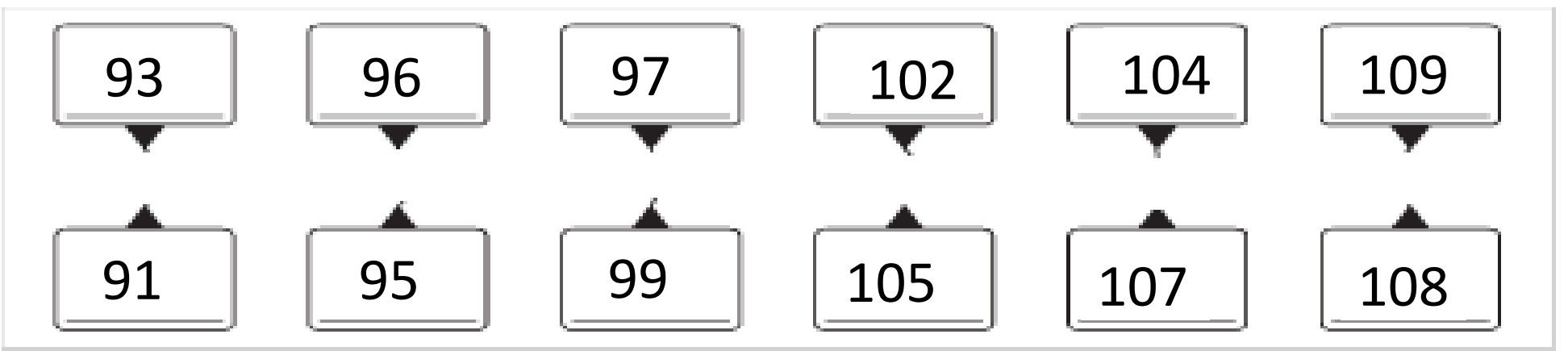
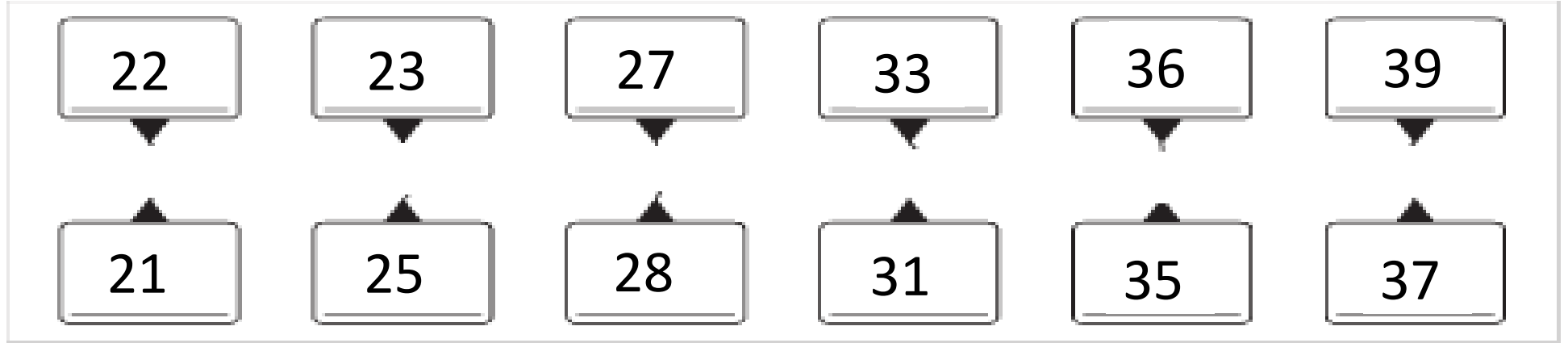
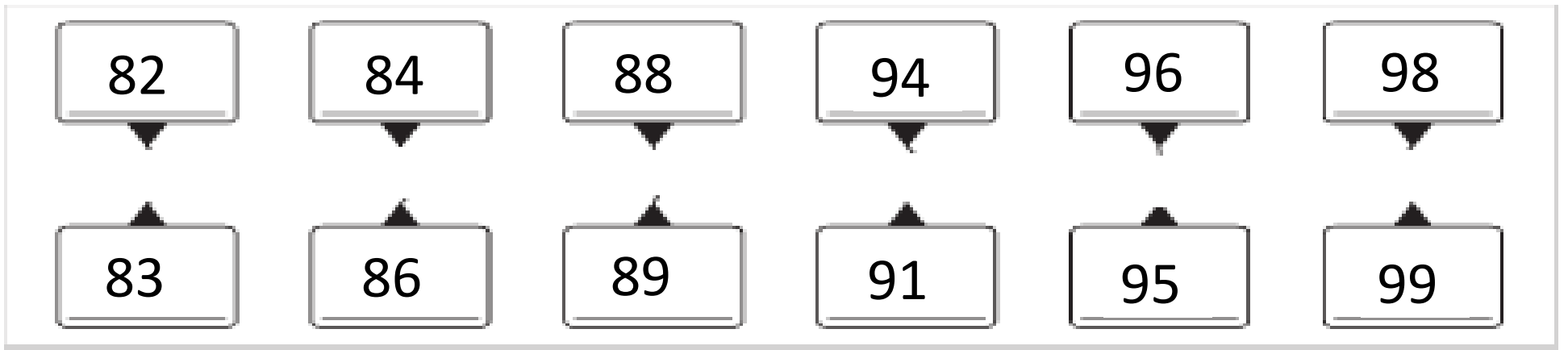
